ATR VERDICT: The drop back from 7f looks ideal for ST PETERS BASILICA, who is a half-brother to Group 2 winning sprinters Spirit Quartz and Caspian Prince, and his own career best came at Doncaster over this trip in November. The Galileo colt has plenty of experience to his name and could make amends to supporters who sent him off co-favourite at Southwell last time. Newcomers Turn To Rock and Fury And Fire need to be respected, while Shug will appreciate stepping back up from 5f.
