**ATR VERDICT:** A repeat of the best of PLAYFULL SPIRIT's form would see her at the head of proceedings here, having shaped with plenty of promise when third in a novice stakes event at Newcastle in November. The Invincible Spirit filly is closely related to Middle Park winner Charming Thought and could be leniently treated heading back into the handicap ranks. The consistent Chica De La Noche was a C&D winner last month and made the podium when looking to follow up at Kempton, while Sweet Nature has some smart form in the book and could be improved by the application of cheekpieces.
