ATR VERDICT: POGUE shaped well on his hurdles debut at Bangor when third to Finawn Bawn, who followed that effort up with a good run in Grade 2 company at Warwick, and the drop in trip looks to be in favour of the son of Stowaway. Captain Moirette ran a nice race after a lengthy absence when fourth over C&D last month and warrants respect along with Kingofthecotswolds, who is likely to be suited by a return to 2m.
