**ATR VERDICT:** SILVER QUAY has been in good form at Taunton, winning back-to-back over this trip under today's pilot Bryony Frost. He's unpenalised for his three-and-a-quarter-length victory in a conditional jockeys' event 10 days ago and rates the one to beat on these terms. Fellow hat-trick seeker Goodgirlteresa won off this mark over fences at Chepstow last month and is interesting now switched back over timber, while Amzac Magic took a forward step when fourth on his handicap debut at Exeter and has viable place claims.
