ATR VERDICT: SILVER QUAY has been in good form at Taunton, winning back-to-back over this trip under today's pilot Bryony Frost. He's unpenalised for his three-and-a-quarter-length victory in a conditional jockeys' event 10 days ago and rates the one to beat on these terms. Fellow hat-trick seeker Goodgirlteresa won off this mark over fences at Chepstow last month and is interesting now switched back over timber, while Amzac Magic took a forward step when fourth on his handicap debut at Exeter and has viable place claims.

ATR VERDICT: LE COEUR NET has been handed a 6lb rise for his 18-length victory over 2m at Ffos Las in November and if he returns in a similar mood there is every chance he'll improve for this step up in trip. Le Capricieux is creeping back down the handicap and could feasibly play a supporting role off his revised perch, while Zen Master appears feasibly treated on his hurdles form, for all his recent chase efforts temper enthusiasm.

ATR VERDICT: All-weather bumper winner BULLFROG made a promising start to her hurdling career when third over 2m at Sandown and, entitled to improve both physically and mentally, she might be able to see off past hurdle winners Dame du Soir and Millarville, who are both burdened with penalties. Deja Vue and The Cull Bank bring winning point-to-point form to the table, while Fakenham third Regarding Ruth is another to note.

ATR VERDICT: SARTORIAL ELEGANCE ran out a comfortable winner over C&D last month and a 5lb rise might not be enough to anchor him if arriving in the same mood. Quinto is just 2lb higher than when half-a-length second at Hereford and he is likely to be in the shake-up again, while the top-rated Camron De Chaillac, not beaten far at Chepstow when last sighted, will benefit from Tom Buckley's 10lb claim.
