ATR VERDICT: AYE RIGHT has been in imperious form this winter, winning three of his four assignments, and following a successful switch to the handicap ranks last time, he rates the one to beat once again. A 4lb rise for beating some useful rivals on that occasion seems fair and there is every chance the extra distance tackled here is well within the six-year-old's reach. Bordeaux Bill hinted at a revival when third at Wetherby last time and appeals off the same mark, while Mistermoonboy is an interesting recruit to handicapping following some useful efforts in maiden hurdles and having Brian Hughes in the saddle is a positive.
