ATR VERDICT: DEISE ABA's victory over Queenohearts was paid a handsome compliment when the latter scored at Haydock in December, and Philip Hobbs' charge can strike again despite an 87-day absence. The six-year-old is preferred to I Can't Explain, who won well on debut for Nicky Henderson but was stuffed at Cheltenham on New Year's Day and has a bit of a point to prove now. Russian Hawk found two good horses too hot to handle over 2m6f here last time but clearly possesses plenty of ability.

ATR VERDICT: Ballyandy did it well at Uttoxeter last time and clearly handles the burden of top-weight well, while Cloudy Glen is chasing a hat-trick for Venetia Williams but has an extra 12lb to handle now. Darling Maltaix can be an awkward ride and needs to be delivered on the line, and his stablemate BRIO CONTI makes some appeal at the current prices. Fully entitled to need the run after a 15-month absence at Sandown two weeks ago, the eight-year-old remains unexposed and looked classy in 2017 when winning the Silver Plate at Kempton and finishing fifth in a Grade 1 at Aintree.

ATR VERDICT: Coneygree has failed to complete on three of his last four starts, though he did show glimpses of promise with a game effort at Cheltenham when third in November behind Rock The Kasbah. Calipto was third in the Sky Bet Chase last time but needs to reduce his jumping errors, and this can go to BLACK CORTON, who was a brave second to Top Notch at Kempton last time and should relish this step up to 3m. Reikers Island was probably set for victory at Newbury in December before making a meal of the last, and should be involved in the latter stages once more.

ATR VERDICT: If this contest has been run at its traditional home, Newbury, then ante-post favourite Al Dancer, an impressive winner at Cheltenham last time out, would have been the one to be on, though the switch to this alternative venue opens up the possibility of DIDTHEYLEAVEUOUTTO landing an opportunistic victory. Nick Gifford's smooth-travelling six-year-old won a Listed bumper here in 2017 and struck over C&D in November on good ground. He needs to leave behind a wayward effort at Kempton on Boxing Day but conditions that day may not have suited and he looks an interesting contender against the market leaders now back on his old stomping ground. Getaway Trump travelled strongly over 2m1f at Exeter in December and could also take a hand now dropping back in trip on the back of picking up the silver medal in the Challow.

ATR VERDICT: WAITING PATIENTLY ran out an impressive winner of this race 12 months ago and, although luckless in the King George subsequently (badly hampered and unseated Brian Hughes at the ninth), everything looks in the place for him to run another massive race. ATR VERDICT: Tim Vaughan has a pair of interesting runners in top weight Trixster, who has won three out of his last four over timber, and Modern Warfair, who struck when switched to handicap company at Doncaster last time. Both have to be considered, as does recent Hereford runner-up Jully Les Buxy, but preference is for EXITAS. Rated 142 over fences after winning easily at Aintree in October, Phil Middleton's charge has been running respectably over the larger obstacles since that success and competes off 20lb lower over timber. Another Emotion has been running well in decent races of late and is another to note.

ATR VERDICT: Silver Forever's winning run came to an end when third in Listed company at Huntingdon having landed a point-to-point and a Chepstow bumper prior to that effort. Paul Nicholls' charge is fancied to run well again, but she has to give lumps of weight to a couple of useful-looking four-year-olds.
