**ATR VERDICT:** Grand Sancy is a hugely likeable type and a winner over C&D, but attempting to give 2lb and a beating to SCEAU ROYAL will be no easy task. Alan King has his horses in great form at present and his seven-year-old, a Grade 2 winner over C&D in the 2016 Elite Hurdle, can put all his experience to good use. With five wins from seven starts over fences since switching to the larger obstacles, including a Grade 1 at Sandown, he should have too much class for Grand Sancy, as well as Vision Des Flos.
