**ATR VERDICT:** French recruit DOGON is clearly well thought of at home and can be forgiven his effort in a Cheltenham Grade 2 on his debut for Paul Nicholls. He is given another chance getting weight all round in this novices' hurdle, although Katpoli won a juvenile hurdle at Huntingdon and subsequently got within four lengths of Quel Destin at Cheltenham, so he must be feared. Lord Duveen rates best of the rest.

**ATR VERDICT:** On the basis that Gino Trail, Bigmartre and Azzuri all like to go forward, this could be run to suit either MAGIC SAINT or Admiral's Secret. The latter refused to race at Haydock last time, which is a huge concern, so Paul Nicholls' unexposed five-year-old is given another chance after what was a slightly disappointing effort at Ascot in December, such was the encouraging nature of his first run for Nicholls at Haydock the time before.

**ATR VERDICT:** Atlanta Ablaze unseated her rider when contesting a similar race at Doncaster in December but had previously won three of her four starts since undergoing wind surgery. Her only defeat came at the hands of the reopposing RONS DREAM at Market Rasen in November, though, and it is difficult to see why that form will be reversed given the selection is better off at the weights.
