ATR VERDICT: A few of these have some excellent form in the book, with Jimmy Rabbitte chasing a four-timer and Fairway Freddy on a hat-trick. They have gone up 10lb and 8lb respectively, though, and need to improve in this stronger contest. Ballon Onabudget remains unexposed ahead of just his second start for Tom George but this can go to POTTERS MIDNIGHT, who carried a big weight to victory at Lingfield a month ago and shouldn't be too inconvenienced by a 7lb rise. She jumps well and ought to be competitive on ground that should suit.

ATR VERDICT: A match race can go the way of the in-form Alan King and CHOSEN PATH. The six-year-old stuck his neck out to land a competitive event at Newbury in December, and he looks to have more to offer over staying trips. He can land this before maybe moving into a handicap at one of the big spring festivals.
