Kahdian reverts to hurdles having picked up a silver medal over the larger obstacles last time and is interesting racing off a light weight, while the veteran Flanagans Field and Iniesta, who is 1lb lower than when last tasting success, are others who enter calculations.

ATR VERDICT: C&D winner Envole Toi sets a useful standard and it is perhaps of note that Sam Twiston-Davies returns to the saddle, although he could be vulnerable to a pair of useful looking four-year-olds in this contest. Montestrel got the better of leading Triumph Hurdle fancy Quel Destin on his hurdles bow at Chepstow in the autumn and despite that form being reversed in a Cheltenham Grade 2 in November, he has to be taken seriously. However, preference is for fellow youngster SCARAMANGA, who looked a work in progress, when third at Ludlow and could improve for that first hurdles outing for a yard that couldn't be in any better form. Useful Flat performer Sofia's Rock opened his hurdles account at Worcester in September and is another who appeals following wind surgery.

ATR VERDICT: Midnightreferendum perhaps set the standard here having placed in the Grade 2 Aintree bumper for mares in the spring and she has already opened her account over hurdles, but she was disappointing at Newbury last time and there are question marks about her ability to handle conditions here, with her best form coming on easier ground. It may be worth taking a chance on FAIR KATE, who finished ahead of the useful Severano when third on her hurdles debut at Chepstow and the extra distance encountered here could suit. Listed bumper winner Dissavril is another who could appreciate the step up in trip, while Market Rasen scorer L'chamise has to be respected.

ATR VERDICT: ANEMOI has done little wrong in three hurdle starts so far this season, winning at both Ascot and Doncaster before finishing third in Listed company over the extended 2m4f at Cheltenham, and he looks sure to mount a bold bid cutting back in distance for his handicap debut. It's great to see Misterton, and Noel Fehily, back in action and the eight-year-old is worth a market check at least on his first outing since finishing ninth in last season's Betfair Hurdle, while Nube Negra and Fidux are other class droppers with claims.
