Greyzee narrowly failed to land a gamble on Tapeta last time and should take another step forward at this sort of level.

ATR VERDICT: SOOQAAN was delivered in the final furlong to score here eight days ago and a 6lb penalty might not be enough to prevent Antony Brittain's charge from following up. Still on a fair mark, he is good enough to hold his form here and could prove too hot for these to handle. Bond Angel has shaped well in defeat the last twice and her record here reads 181132, while Thunder Buddy is another course specialist who warrants respect wearing cheekpieces for the first time.

ATR VERDICT: SO HI SPEED showed enough last season to suggest that he can win one of these and it is worth noting ahead of his Fibresand debut that he has been gelded since he was last seen in July. The three-year-old was deemed good enough to run in a conditions race in France and won't get a better chance than this to shed the maiden tag. Kadiz has plenty of early pace and looks a danger, while newcomer Gupta requires a market check.
