ATR VERDICT: COOLAGH MAGIC has impressively notched a Newcastle/Southwell double and although a further 6lb rise will obviously make life more difficult, Richard Fahey's progressive colt might be able to complete the hat-trick at a venue where he has run well in the past. Liberation Day gamely won a 7f course maiden last month and warrants plenty of respect switching to handicap company with first-time cheekpieces equipped, while Fares Kodiak, who boasts two wins from four starts so far, also merits consideration.
