



**ATR VERDICT:** The form of YOUNG WOLF's Hereford third looks strong, with the two horses ahead of him performing well since, and this could be the perfect opportunity for Neon Wolf's brother to open his hurdling account. Enfin Phil was a winner in France and produced an encouraging run at Wetherby for third, with Captain Moirette fourth. Zoffany Bay has the talented Danny McMenamin in the saddle and shouldn't be ignored, while market support for Sebastian's Wish must be respected on his jumping bow.

**ATR VERDICT:** The form of I'M WISER NOW's Wetherby third has worked out well, with the fourth and fifth both winning since, and Fergal O'Brien's charge can make it third-time lucky.
