



ATR VERDICT: SALUTE THE SOLDIER only found a useful rival narrowly too good in his bid for a hat-trick over C&D when last seen in December. A 2lb rise for that effort is fair and he has proven that he can win following a break in the past. Tough Remedy has already had a productive spell on the all-weather this winter and he could put in another good effort. Others to consider are Ballard Down, Executive Force and Gurkha Friend.

Paradise Boy was headed on the post over the extended 1m1f here last month and could appreciate the return to further, given he'd previously landed a 1m4f maiden at Lingfield. Thunderoad, beaten by a neck in a C&D handicap last month, looks best of the rest.

ATR VERDICT: TIGER EYE is improving between runs and backed up her C&D novice victory in January when defying a penalty over 7f again at Lingfield recently. James Fanshawe's four-year-old is expected to show up well off an opening mark of 83 on her handicap bow. Toy Theatre won stylishly in this grade over 1m from Ventura Blues at Newcastle and could be putting in her best work in at the finish as she bids to shake off a 7lb rise.

Singing The Blues is interesting on a hat-trick, while Rail Dancer and Enmeshing are also worth mentioning.

ATR VERDICT: WISE WORDS caught the eye when second on debut at Newcastle last month, shaping as though she would learn plenty from the experience. The three-year-old is related to plenty of winners and can defy a poor draw in stall 12 to score. Phosphor had a bit of a reputation last year for Martyn Meade and could take a step forward on seasonal reappearance, while Global Prospector cost 800,000gns as a two-year-old last April and warrants a market check.
