







ATR VERDICT: BRIAC ran well behind a progressive individual when dropped back to 2m on his latest start at Sandown last month and he makes plenty of appeal tackling 3m for the first time in his career being winner over 2m6f at Ffos Las three starts ago. Midnight Bliss has been running well enough of late to suggest another solid display is in the offing, while Reckless Behavior is turned out quickly after whipping round and unseating at the start at Uttoxeter on Saturday but warrants respect if the market speaks in his favour once again.

The result was still in the balance on that occasion but this looks a good opportunity for him to make it three wins on the bounce with his rivals all having something to prove. Savello was 18 lengths behind the selection in the aforementioned contest and he can follow him home, while Broughtons Rhythm could be in the mix if in the mood.

ATR VERDICT: Larkbarrow Lad has landed the silver medal on each of his last three outings and will be hoping to go one better having since undergone wind surgery. Marginal preference, however, is for IMPERIAL KNIGHT, who represents a stable in red-hot form and took a step in the right direction in this sphere when placed at Ascot last time. Point winner Accordingtorgino could have better to offer under Rules, while Doncesar De Pretot is worth a market check now sporting first-time cheekpieces.

ATR VERDICT: SUNDANCE BOY was all out to score over 3m here two weeks ago and is expected to benefit from this drop back in distance as he bids to notch a quick double. Blue Rhythm is fitted with a first-time visor after picking up some minor money over the extended 2m4f at Huntingdon last time and can fight it out for the silver medal with Iniesta, whose two latest efforts around 2m3f suggest his winning turn is fast approaching.

ATR VERDICT: Yeavinger Belle struck on her first start under Rules at Warwick last month and is expected to give it a good go under a penalty, though narrow preference is for EYES RIGHT, who receives weight from the selection and makes some appeal on her Newbury second in December and Ascot fourth latest. Destinys Choice changed hands for 70,000 pounds and is returning from a break but bolted up between the flags last year so she's another to bear in mind on her NH bow.
