ATR VERDICT: PETITE JACK was demoted into second by the stewards' after causing interference here two starts ago (with the race awarded to Exceeding Power) but he gained compensation with a C&D victory last week (with Fire Fighting back in third) and looks to be back to his best now in the care of Neil King again. He bids to defy a penalty this afternoon but he's still fairly treated on his Listed win for Archie Watson here in December 2017 and James Doyle has been booked. The handicapper has cut Amazing Red some slack and he's a viable contender for the silver medal.
