**ATR VERDICT:** TIGHT CALL was still in with a shout of finishing in the money when falling at the last in a hot Ascot handicap last time and could return to winning ways now back in novice company, having landed a similar contest in emphatic style at Hereford earlier in the season. Course winner Morraman was slightly disappointing when favourite last time but has since undergone wind surgery and has to be respected, while Dr Hooves has had a similar procedure and could bounce back to his best representing a top northern set up.

**ATR VERDICT:** GEMOLOGIST was hampered when making her challenge at the last over course and distance last time, having to settle for third on her first start for Lucinda Russell, but could gain compensation here on her handicap debut off an inviting opening mark. Wot A Shot is only 2lb higher than winning over track and trip earlier this year and is respected with Brian Hughes in the saddle, while James Reveley comes in for a rare UK ride aboard Great Colaci and Gillian Boanas' six-year-old is worthy of a market check.

**ATR VERDICT:** Sam England is having her best season as a trainer to date and her progressive chaser WISHFULL DREAMING is backed to follow up his comfortable course success earlier this month under a 7lb penalty. The eight-year-old has taken well to fences since switched from hurdles at the turn of the year and could continue on an upward curve here. Lucinda Russell is mob-handed in opposition, the best of which may be course specialist Elmono, who has won twice here over the larger obstacles this year, while stablemate The Road Home was second over course and distance last time and is just 1lb higher now.
