**ATR VERDICT:** Dermot McLaughlin may have found the ideal opportunity for his Irish raider CAPTAIN CJ, who has useful form behind the high-class Carefully Selected in both bumper and hurdle events and got within two lengths of Cap York at Navan in December, with that rival going on to perform respectably in Graded contests. Shaman Du Berlais looked the most likely winner when falling at the second-last obstacle at Catterick last time and Tim Vaughan's six-year-old could pick up some compensation here, while Largy Prospect was an easy winner at Ayr earlier this month and could progress again stepping up in trip.

**ATR VERDICT:** Lucinda Russell looks to have a strong hand here with a pair of recent winners, the best of which may well be SAINT FREULE, who opened his account under Rules in tenacious fashion when battling to a short-head victory over course and distance last time. Stablemate Mint Gold took advantage of the favourite departing at the third-last hurdle to cause a surprise at 50/1 last time, but looked full of improvement that day and is respected stepping into handicap company. Murphy's Law, Snookered and Gold Runner, who was second off this rating at Ayr last time, are others to note.

**ATR VERDICT:** GRAYSTOWN kept on well to score at Ayr last time and with cheekpieces now tried to help his jumping, he could build on that success off a 5lb higher mark. The form of his triumph on the west coast of Scotland has worked out well with the second winning comfortably on his next start and the selection should have enough to see off Paul Stafford's Well Joey, who appreciated the heavy ground when second over course and distance earlier this month and is given a chance racing off the same rating. Katalystic was third here when last seen and could have a part to play if not inconvenienced by the drop in trip, while Roxyfet remains feasibly treated but has a point to prove away from his beloved Sedgefield.
