ATR VERDICT: TALKTOMENOW has shown potential in his short career so far and could benefit from first-time cheekpieces and having Richard Johnson in the saddle. The five-year-old was second to the smart Getaway Trump in November and, despite failing to run his race the last twice, looks poised to bounce back here. New Quay should find this easier than recent assessments, while Ratfacemcdougall beat a subsequent Grade 2 winner back in December and is also noted.
