**ATR VERDICT:** BOUTONNIERE is an unexposed quantity and can build on his recent Lingfield victory. He got off the mark in a likeable fashion on that occasion, having progressed nicely run by run, and it will be interesting to see how his ability transfers to turf for a handler who has started the season well. Fraser Island's performances last season were creditable and the consistent performer is respected at a track his trainer often does well at, while Gabriel The One, who was a good winner at Pontefract in October, arrives here running off a 6lb higher mark and is another to note.
