Timeform says: Winner of both starts last season, a 7f minor event and 1m handicap (both at Salisbury) in June. Absent since (gelded and undergone wind surgery in the interim), but he remains with potential.

TIMEFORM VIEW: The vote goes to BERINGER, who came from well off the pace to finish a joint third with Breden in the Lincoln. On that evidence, Alan King's charge remains on a workable mark and he should strip fitter this time. Breden should again give it his all, but bigger threats may be posed by Power of Darkness and Sawwaah, both of whom have low mileage and remain open to improvement.
