ATR VERDICT: KILLULTAGH VIC hasn't tasted success since December 2017 and might not get a better chance to do so than this. Willie Mullins' veteran would be hard to beat if replicating the level of performance shown when third in the Galmoy Hurdle at Gowran Park earlier this year and is well ahead of this field on official ratings back over fences. Westerner Point has looked progressive in victory the last twice and deserves to step up to this level, while Call It Magic unseated at a relatively early stage in the Topham at Aintree last time but is still respected.
