ATR VERDICT: SUNSET FLASH made short work of her rivals when sauntering clear to record an eight-length success over seven furlongs at Newcastle in November and, being a half-sister to US 1m turf winner Excellent Sunset, can be expected to improve further now granted a stiffer stamina test. She can land this en route to better things and is handed a confident vote. Song Without End shaped with promise on debut when finishing sixth over seven furlongs at Kempton in September and he looks clear second best ahead of Fields Of Dreams.

ATR VERDICT: DIAMOND OASIS highlighted her resolution to record a determined success over a mile at Chelmsford earlier this month and she can be rated a bit higher for that victory after racing keenly off a slow gallop. The daughter of Iffraaj looks the type to win again and a mark of 77 doesn't appear too harsh for this handicap bow. Gleeful did not enjoy the clearest of runs when fourth over six furlongs at Yarmouth on her last race as a juvenile and she merits respect, while Chasing The Rain had the form of her novice win handsomely boosted when the runner-up scored next time out and she adds further intrigue to a decent looking event.


