**ATR VERDICT:** SANTANI proved to be very consistent in handicaps on the Flat in France without getting his head in front, but this looks an ideal opportunity to gain his first career success with the opposition having shown limited promise over timber. **ATR VERDICT:** BABY KING has to give 24lb and upwards to his three rivals, but he has steadily crept down the weights this season and his third at Warwick in January off 3lb higher suggests he is still capable of winning when presented with the right opportunity. All Is Good has a tongue-tie and cheekpieces on for the first time and, if bouncing back from being pulled up at Taunton, can pose the most solid threat to the selection, while Billy Hicks can win the battle for third against Spock.

**ATR VERDICT:** YOUNG WOLF has been brought along steadily by Jonjo O'Neill and was inconvenienced by the drop in distance when third at Catterick in February. Now stepped up to 3m for the first time, this is likely to bring out the best in him being a half-brother to Lake View Lad and a full relation to the ill-fated Neon Wolf. Hepijeu returns to timber having landed a hat-trick in the autumn before a trio of seconds over fences, while Manning Estate shaped at Fontwell last month as though 3m would pose no issues.

**ATR VERDICT:** VENDREDI TROIS enjoyed a consistent spell in 2018, only finishing out of the first three in a jumpers' bumper at Kempton in March, and was last seen finishing third to the progressive Cloth Cap at Stratford in November. If returning in similar form, he can take advantage of what appears a winnable contest on paper. Master Burbidge is a strong traveller but flattered to deceive when second at Newbury last time, so the main danger could come from Jaunty Flyer with Richard Johnson taking over in the saddle.

**ATR VERDICT:** BERGAMOT could be the answer here following some useful runs in defeat in bumpers so far.
