ATR VERDICT: WHATWOULDYOUKNOW was unable to land the hat-trick at Chelmsford when last seen in December, but Richard Guest's gelding can take another step forward after a 140-day absence in what looks a winnable contest on paper. Never Be Enough didn't appear to get home on handicap debut at Musselburgh over 1m4f last October so is respected dropping in trip with a hood on for the first time, while Agar's Plough showed promise on his debut for Mick Easterby and could be suited by the step up in distance.
