ATR VERDICT: CHAMPAGNE NOIR was bought for 70,000 pounds shortly after his promising third-placed effort between the flags at Boulta in December and he looks to have a great chance of getting his NH career off to a flyer. Floki hasn't been without promise in a couple of bumper starts, finishing less than seven lengths behind the high-class Emitom first time out, and warrants plenty of respect on his hurdling debut, while My Charity completes the shortlist following his runner-up effort in a Wetherby handicap.

ATR VERDICT: COOPERS SQUARE has won each of his last five outings when completing the track (unseated Alan Johns at Huntingdon four runs ago) and, despite a further 6lb rise for his last-start Exeter success, Tom Weston's in-form gelding could hit the target again. There didn't appear to be any fluke about Change Ur Tune's 20/1 success at Bangor and he should remain competitive off 9lb higher, with Eaton Miller and Danseur Du Large others to keep an eye on.

ATR VERDICT: The ability is most definitely there with MIDNIGHTREFERENDUM, having placed in a Grade 2 bumper at last year's Aintree Festival, and recent wind surgery could be just what was needed to help the past course winner bounce back to form. Forgot To Ask showed the positive effects from the same procedure when third at Wincanton last time and he must enter calculations lining up off an unchanged mark, while Cardigan Bay and Nigh Or Never also merit consideration.

ATR VERDICT: BOUGHTBEFORELUNCH was touched off by under a length over track and trip when last sighted and although the handicapper has reacted by handing him a 7lb rise, he pulled 12 lengths clear of the third last time and likely has further improvement in the pipeline on what is only his seventh chase start. C&D winner Irish Octave is 6lb higher than when striking at Chepstow recently (a race Domingo pulled-up in on his seasonal return) but is feared most.
