Mutadaffeq was successful in novice company at Cork earlier this week and looks to follow up quickly now returned to the handicap ranks under a 6lb penalty, while Castlehume progressed nicely up the ratings last summer thanks to a couple of victories and a narrow defeat at Sligo and is of interest returning for a new handler after a spell off the track.
