Stop Talking has won four of her last five, impressing at Perth when a five-length victor last time. She is a must for the shortlist, along with Kempton scorer Peggies Venture and Ratoute Yutty, who has some useful form and is worth trying over this trip once again.

The eight-year-old remains on a mark of 137 and merits plenty of respect for connections who thrive at this time of year.
