ATR VERDICT: LIGHT ANGEL was very green on his debut over 5f at Doncaster a couple of weeks ago but he overcame that inexperience to only be beaten by a neck. The step up in trip should help this relation to Lope De Vega and he should be more streetwise. There are a whole host of well-bred newcomers in this field but the one that stands out is Sir Oliver, who cost 115,000gns as a yearling. The son of Dark Angel is a full-brother to the dual Nunthorpe winner Mecca's Angel as well as the Group 3 winner Markaz. Heaven Forfend is a full-brother to the black-type performer Seven Heavens, while the 180,000gns purchase Baadirr is another who merits a place on the shortlist.

ATR VERDICT: John Gosden holds a strong hand here and jockey bookings suggest Arabist is the pick of his two newcomers, slightly ahead of Logician.
