ATR VERDICT: Jaleel ran creditably on his reappearance at Lingfield earlier this month, without suggesting that he would be one of Roger Varian's superstars this season. He is worth noting, while Songkran was far from disgraced in a deeper handicap at York nine days ago. Smile A Mile has a nice low draw and could be handed an aggressive ride from it, but that could tee things up for ZOFFEE, who runs over a mile for the first time on grass. Tom Dascombe and Richard Kingscote have an excellent record here, and a mark of 77 could be generous for this three-year-old.
