ATR VERDICT: Top Buck arrives here on the back of a third-placed finish in the Lily Agnes at Chester last time out and he has to be respected this afternoon. That said, preference is for VISIBLE CHARM, who represents a yard who have made an outstanding start to the season with their juveniles. The son of Invincible Spirit is a half-brother to Erupt, who won the Grand Prix de Paris and Canadian International, and he displayed enough promise at a breeze-up sale last month for connections to part with 575,000gns. Pierre Lapin is another newcomer to note having cost 140,000gns as a yearling and he is a half-brother to the July Cup winner Harry Angel.

ATR VERDICT: Perfect Rose displayed plenty of promise when finishing third on her debut over 5f at Kempton in early April and she should put her experience to good use this afternoon. That said, a chance can be taken with BYZANTIA, who is from the first crop of the Derby and Arc winner Golden Horn. This filly represents the same connections as her sire and she is out of a mare who won a Listed race as juvenile, which suggests that she could be sharp enough for this test. Sacred Dance cost 650,000gns as a yearling and she is a half-sister to the dual Listed winner Awesometank, while Rhea and Zmile are other interesting newcomers.

ATR VERDICT: She's Apples is likely better than she showed at Nottingham on turf debut 44 days ago and can be handed another chance for Roger Charlton. Kensington Art shaped like he might be worth a try over this sort of distance when finishing stoutly at Beverley recently, while Highwaygrey has found just one too good the last twice. It might take a good one to defy SWANSDOWN, who was Luca Cumani's last ever runner in November.
