**ATR VERDICT:** Perfect Rose displayed plenty of promise when finishing third on her debut over 5f at Kempton in early April and she should put her experience to good use this afternoon. That said, a chance can be taken with BYZANTIA, who is from the first crop of the Derby and Arc winner Golden Horn. This filly represents the same connections as her sire and she is out of a mare who won a Listed race as juvenile, which suggests that she could be sharp enough for this test. Sacred Dance cost 650,000gns as a yearling and she is a half-sister to the dual Listed winner Awesometank, while Rhea and Zmile are other interesting newcomers.
