











**ATR VERDICT:** AL MUFFRIH was his own worst enemy when running too freely on his handicap debut at Newmarket, letting down favourite-backers who expected him to make a successful return. He retains plenty of potential, though, and William Haggas' decision to reach for a hood could have the desired effect. Epaulement went out on his shield in testing conditions at Chester and had Society Red back in fifth when making a victorious comeback at Ripon prior to that. Lunar Jet has already paid his way this season, while Commander Han could bounce back from his York no-show.
