ATR VERDICT: CORRI LINDO disappointed favourite backers at Bangor latest but his effort wasn't devoid of promise and, given he finished a short-head second prior to that on stable debut for Henry Oliver, he wouldn't be winning out of turn. Similar sentiments apply to Gambling Gamut, who has been running well in defeat over hurdles and is interesting going over fences for the first time, while Potters Story is unexposed over the larger obstacles and is another to note.

ATR VERDICT: Boltissime is an intriguing recruit for Dr Richard Newland from France and could make an impact on debut under Sam Twiston-Davies, while Iconic Hero could take a step forward after a debut under Rules that wasn't devoid of promise for Dan Skelton four weeks ago. Preference, though, is for SWAFFHAM BULBECK, who scored at Fakenham before finding just one too good at Market Rasen a month later. ATR VERDICT: BALLADAME showed a fair amount of promise when runner-up on her racecourse bow at Ffos Las and Tom George's filly wouldn't need to improve much from that performance to get her head in front. Malina Ocarina finished third on her debut at Newton Abbot and comes from a decent National Hunt family, which contains Champion Chase hero Klairon Davis, while point-to-point winner Bannixtown Glory represents a stable in good heart currently and has to enter calculations on her debut under Rules.
