ATR VERDICT: Anna's Fast and Kimari both showed blistering speed to win impressively on their respective debuts at Keeneland in April and the pair bring a strong pace angle to the contest as they are both drawn high. Final Song leads a strong representation for Godolphin, having scored over C&D in great style last month, along with Ickworth, a Listed winner at the Curragh, and the Charlie Appleby pairing of Divine Spirit and Theory Of Time. Flippa The Strippa boasts a success in Listed company and appeals as being a sharp early type but, at the prices, a chance is taken with RAFFLE PRIZE. Despite the fact she has raced exclusively over 6f to date, she did well to win at Chester on her second start having maintained a strong pace throughout so the drop to a stiff 5f is unlikely to pose any concerns. The booking of Frankie Dettori and stall 25 are both in her favour, with the aforementioned Wesley Ward pair drawn close to her, and the daughter of Slade Power can continue her trainer's fine record at the Royal meeting.

ATR VERDICT: Norway was not disgraced when finishing eighth in the Derby at the beginning of the month, especially as he was up there forcing the pace throughout. The step up in trip should suit this stoutly-bred son of Galileo and he has to be given the utmost respect. That said, preference is for JALMOUD, who remains unexposed and marathon trips looked sure to suit when he got up narrowly in a French Listed race over 1m4f last month. That form was boosted when the second and third filled the same positions in a Group 2 at the weekend and the ground should not be a problem for Charlie Appleby's colt. Western Australia will have to run to a higher level than when winning a Navan Listed race last month but he remains unexposed over this kind of trip, while Nate The Great could go well if seeing out the trip.

ATR VERDICT: Sir Michael Stoute won this last year with Poet's Word and comes into this with another star contender in the shape of Crystal Ocean, who finished second to Cracksman in the Champion Stakes here last October and remains unbeaten in two starts so far this season. Prix De L'Arc De Triomphe second Sea of Class makes her seasonal reappearance for William Haggas and a big run from her would be no surprise, while Waldgeist put in a career-best performance when landing the Prix Ganay at Longchamp in April and has had this as his target ever since. Marginal preference, though, is for Aidan O'Brien's MAGICAL, who is one of three fillies in the race receiving a 3lb pull in the weights. Second behind Enable in the Breeders' Cup Turf, she is unbeaten in three starts this season and looks hard to beat over her optimum trip.

ATR VERDICT: Rawdaa put in a career best when only a neck behind Lah Ti Dar in the Middleton at York in May, but that came over 1m2f and she had previously been beaten by Agrotera at Kempton. The latter won the Sandringham over C&D at this meeting last year and she has a solid each-way chance this afternoon. However, the one to beat is I CAN FLY, who has the best form in this race by quite a long way. The daughter of Fastnet Rock was only beaten a neck by Roaring Lion in the QEII here last October and she was not disgraced when finishing sixth in the Lockinge earlier in the season. The four-year-old was given far too much to do when a beaten favourite last time out and she can provide her supporters with some valuable compensation. Pretty Baby has to prove that she stays this trip but if she does see it out then it would be no surprise to see her in the mix.

ATR VERDICT: New Graduate was an impressive winner of a competitive contest at Ripon when last seen in April but stall one has to be a big concern, given that most of the pace appears to be middle to high. With that in mind, preference is for CHIEF IRONSIDE, who could be underestimated in the market. The son of Lawman only found Lord Glitters and Mustashry too good in the Group 3 Strensall Stakes at York last summer and bounced back from two disappointing efforts on soft ground with a third-placed finish in the Diomed Stakes at Epsom on Derby day. As a result, William Jarvis' colt is 4lb well in today and he could still be improving. Zhui Feng caught the eye when staying on into third on his seasonal return at Goodwood. The six-year-old is 4lb higher than when winning this race two years ago but he is 2lb lower then when only a neck second in the Victoria Cup last season. Seniority was not disgraced at Epsom recently and he is another who could make the frame, while Robin Of Navan and Kynren are others with each-way claims.


