ATR VERDICT: Bar Room Bore is clearly much better than showing in a Roscommon handicap two weeks ago and, being the top-rated performer in this line-up, he warrants respect on his first start at Plating level. However, CLIARA receives 10lb off the gelding rated 9lb her superior and shades the verdict following her fast-finishing fourth over 7f on the same Roscommon card. Last week's Sligo third Scotts Honor also merits consideration.
