ATR VERDICT: No Hassle Hoff wouldn't be a surprise winner, but it is a slight concern that he couldn't justify cramped odds at Hexham latest and this is arguably tougher as the in-form POTTERMAN looks a smart fencing prospect. A winner over hurdles at Warwick two starts back, he made no mistake on his chasing debut over at Worcester when beating a 135-rated animal by some 10 lengths. Litterale Ci is interesting on her return to action and is noted.

ATR VERDICT: BARRANCO VALLEY returned from over three years off the track with a satisfactory effort when fourth at Exeter back in March. He has since undergone wind surgery and that, combined with the application of a tongue-tie, could see him take a step forward after a 100-day absence. Nonesuch displayed some ability in bumpers and may well be suited by a step up in distance, while Represented had excuses when last seen in November, due to the Anthony Honeyball stable not fully firing, and he is better judged on his hurdling debut at the same course a fortnight earlier.

ATR VERDICT: MINELLACELEBRATION defied a 13-month absence to strike at Aintree earlier this month, and natural improvement would make the nine-year-old tough to stop despite a 5lb rise. Katy Price's charge obviously hasn't been easy to train having raced just twice since the end of 2017, but he is talented and doesn't have many miles on the clock for his age. Psychedelic Rock likes a sound surface but needs to improve his jumping, while recent C&D scorer Bally Longford is another to take seriously.

ATR VERDICT: Heavey was far from disgraced on his bumper debut when fourth of 13 at Fontwell in February and despite shaping there like he needed further, he could be better here following a 122-day break and a wind operation. Dromineer carries a 7lb penalty after winning in this sphere at Taunton 63 days ago and is bred to improve further, but this can go to HIGH CHANGE. A rare runner in this sphere for Charlie Hills, he should have the pace for this and the booking of Jonjo O'Neill Jr catches the eye.
