**ATR VERDICT:** Roger Varian has a solid record here and arrives in good form having had three winners at Royal Ascot last week, so it wouldn't be a shock to see DARING VENTURE go close on her handicap debut. A mark of 75 looks fair for the Dabirsim filly and she showed glimpses of promise when fourth at Newmarket 19 days ago behind some potentially smart sorts. Defence Treaty has taken time to come good but impressed when scoring at Leicester earlier this month, while course winner Gale Force Maya looks the pick of three interesting Michael Dods runners.

**ATR VERDICT:** NORTHERN HOPE showed plenty on debut when second at Beverley behind a rival with more experience, and natural improvement would make David O'Meara's charge tough to stop. A half-brother to an all-weather winner, the two-year-old can take this before moving onto better things. You're My Rock is an intriguing newcomer for Richard Fahey and appeals more than his once-raced stablemate Trickydickysimpson, while Gallaside was beaten at odds-on at Carlisle in May but soft ground may not have suited on that occasion.

**ATR VERDICT:** LONDON EYE is slowly becoming a frustrating horse to follow, having suffered defeat on both his starts in handicap company when sent off favourite, but he may be worth another chance on this occasion. The son of Australia never appeared happy on testing ground at Carlisle 27 days ago and he looks more than capable of getting off the mark at the sixth attempt. Theatro relished the step up to 1m4f on her handicap bow at Ripon last Thursday, scoring by 12 lengths, and she has to enter calculations being 6lb well-in under a penalty, while Tammooz and Dubai Philosopher both appear to have further improvement in the locker.

**ATR VERDICT:** BOWERMAN is lightly raced and remains open to further progression based on his handicap success over C&D at the end of April. Roger Varian's entire went up 9lb for that performance, which was more than merited, and he can continue his fine all-weather record, with his only defeat coming here to dual Gold Cup hero Stradivarius on debut in November 2016. Seniority missed the Hunt Cup at Royal Ascot last week on account of the ground and is respected on his second at Epsom last time, while others to note include recent course winner Crownthorpe, Military Law and Baltic Baron.
