Bayroot is 5lb worse off so the biggest threat could come in the shape of Motakhayyel, who bumped into a smart John Gosden prospect at Yarmouth. Akwaan steps up in class after completing a brace at the same seaside circuit, and Hamilton winner/Britannia sixth Victory Command can't be dismissed either.

ATR VERDICT: Ropy Guest fared slightly better than Maxi Boy in the Coventry but the suspicion immediately after the race was that it may not be the strongest renewal. Year Of The Tiger also went to the Royal meeting, finishing seventh in the Chesham, before scoring at Naas, but they come across a clutch of interesting once-raced winners. Mystery Power might be the pick of the Hannon pair, while Shared Belief and Juan Elcano did it well at Sandown and Haydock respectively, but KING'S COMMAND overcame trouble over 6f here and should relish the extra furlong.

ATR VERDICT: William Haggas has a strong hand here with the Royal runner Flarepath, who is interesting on her first handicap outing having gone close over track and trip on her reappearance last month, and the more experienced Ice Gala, who placed in Listed company as a two-year-old and has already tasted success this term. Salayel makes her first outing for Roger Varian having regularly got involved at Jebel Ali when with her former handler. Aim Power drops back in trip having run well for a long way in the Sandringham at Royal Ascot, with Model Guest, fifth in that aforementioned event, now tried in blinkers having somewhat disappointed in maiden company last time. Therefore it may be wise to side with CHALEUR, a winner on the Rowley Mile over this trip to finish her two-year-old campaign and having placed in a Group 2 at this meeting last summer, could have the class to carry top-weight to victory on her first outing of 2019.

ATR VERDICT: ADVERTISE announced himself at the sprinting top-table when staying on strongly in first-time blinkers to land the Commonwealth Cup at Royal Ascot last month. Martyn Meade's Showcasing colt rates as the one to beat now campaigning over his optimum trip, having landed the Group 2 July Stakes over course and distance at this meeting last summer. Ten Sovereigns was fourth when sent off favourite for that Group 1 at the Royal meeting and he leads a three-strong Aidan O'Brien challenge. Stablemate Fairyland could appreciate the return to six furlongs and is a Group 1 winner over this distance, while So Perfect goes the other way and drops back in yardage having been last sighted over seven furlongs in the Jersey Stakes. Dream Of Dreams got closest to Blue Point in the Diamond Jubilee and must be seen as a leading contender, while Cape Byron is two from two in 2019 and is well worth a go at this level following his comfortable Wokingham Stakes triumph. 2016 winner Limato warmed up for this with a win in the Group 3 Criterion Stakes and will have plenty of supporters, with track-and-trip winner Pretty Pollyanna another to consider.
