





ATR VERDICT: VICTORIANO was touched off by under a length over this trip at Yarmouth when last sighted and is expected to remain competitive following a 1lb rise in the ratings. Fellow three-year-old Mister Chiang has been raised 3lb for scoring over 1m4f at Pontefract but could improve for this stiffer test and put up most resistance, while Singing The Blues went close off this mark over 1m5f here last month and looks the pick of the older horses.
