Iskabeg Lane has gone close the last twice and is another to consider at a venue that should suit his prominent tactics.

**ATR VERDICT:** Course-and-distance winner Oliver's Gold has been in good form since a second here in February kick-started a run of six podium finishes in a row and the 11-year-old has to be respected. However, in even better fettle is CIVIL UNREST, who got the better of the aforementioned rival at Hexham in May and can confirm superiority off a 2lb higher mark. Un Beau Roman has been raised 5lb for his Worcester near-miss last time but is considered all the same, while Overtoujay shouldn't be discounted for local handler Charles Pogson.
