ATR VERDICT: CONRON scored on the Flat at Clonmel in April before following that form up when second in a competitive Punchestown Festival handicap hurdle a few weeks later, and Jessica Harrington's charge could be worth following after a break. A rating of 77 in this sphere could still underestimate him and he may prove too strong for Trossachs, who has been raised 12lb for his recent Leopardstown success. Shakespear'sgalley is reliable at this level and looks best of the remainder.
