ATR VERDICT: Volcanic Sky was only beaten half a length into third at Carlisle and he is likely to be in the shake-up again, but preference is for the less-exposed QUICKSAND. Hughie Morrison's filly hasn't done a great deal wrong during her short racing career to date and, after not appearing to get home over 1m6f at Wetherby last time, this drop back in trip looks a smart move. Similar applies to Unit of Assessment, who disappointed over 1m6f latest but won nicely over 1m4f the time before, while Windsor runner-up C'Est No Mour adds further spice to the race.
