ATR VERDICT: Global Spirit got the better of Esprit De Corps (second) when meeting at Ayr earlier in the month and the latter upheld that effort, when filling the same spot at the same track nine days ago. The pair reoppose with the latter receiving 2lb, which could see David Barron's gelding reverse the form, but the three-year-old REAL SMOOTH gets the nod. ATR VERDICT: Volcanic Sky was only beaten half a length into third at Carlisle and he is likely to be in the shake-up again, but preference is for the less-exposed QUICKSAND. Hughie Morrison's filly hasn't done a great deal wrong during her short racing career to date and, after not appearing to get home over 1m6f at Wetherby last time, this drop back in trip looks a smart move. ATR VERDICT: In a moderate contest it is hard to oppose ALICIA DARCY, who arrives here on the back of two impressive victories and she is only 4lb higher than her most recent success, despite having to carry a 6lb penalty. Awa Bomba won well on the Fibresand at Southwell last time out and will be a player if transferring that form to the turf. Montalvan is another recent winner who merits consideration.
