
ATR VERDICT: QAYSAR didn't seem to enjoy his experience on the polytrack at Chelmsford last time and is better judged on his previous third at Beverley, where he ran well despite trouble in running. The four-year-old was deemed good enough to run in the Victoria Cup in May and is well treated off 89. Quick Breath is a consistent, gutsy type and enters calculations, while Moraawed is better than what he showed at York last month.
