ATR VERDICT: STARS IN THE SKY wasn't disgraced in a hot novice contest at Ascot last month and natural improvement would make her of serious interest now tackling an extra furlong. The 525,000 euros yearling is the second foal of dual Group 3 hero Maureen, and has to be taken seriously for a yard that is 10-31 with runners of this age group in the last five years on Town Moor. Alpen Rose was a promising second on debut at Newmarket and holds a Group 1 entry, while Ruby Shield looks best of the newcomers on paper.

ATR VERDICT: Double Martini has a 7lb penalty to carry after winning a maiden in Ireland three months ago, but he is an interesting recruit to the Roger Fell team and warrants respect tackling 6f for the first time. ATR VERDICT: DOUBLE KODIAC hasn't been seen on the track for 121 days, but he might be on a fair handicap mark of 85 and could strike on his debut in this sphere under Hayley Turner for the first time. Only a length-and-a-quarter second to the 109-rated Fox Champion in a conditions race at Newmarket in April, which is particularly strong form, and he might be open to greater improvement than the likes of Motafaawit and Remarkable. Recent Newmarket scorer Rum Runner is also respected.
