ATR VERDICT: FLYING PURSUIT has winning track-and-trip form in the book and has now dropped 5lb lower than when striking at York last summer. Tim Easterby's gelding could better his last effort at Thirsk now back over his optimum distance. Alaadel was narrowly beaten by Dalton on testing ground at Nottingham on his seasonal bow and appears fairly handicapped, while Pipers Note cannot be ignored on his favourite stomping ground, though he ideally prefers faster conditions.

ATR VERDICT: Front-runners Raselasad and Lamloom should ensure there is no hanging around and could tee it up for HORTZADAR.
