ATR VERDICT: SO MACHO appears to have been found the perfect opportunity to get off the mark at the sixth attempt. Brambledown has finished fourth on both his starts to date and could have more to offer, while Ecstasea is better than her handicap debut at Yarmouth suggests.

ATR VERDICT: Good Luck Charm had shown nothing prior to scoring at Lingfield last time out, seemingly appreciating the switch to a mile, but he is far from certain to follow up under a 4lb penalty. Master Poet isn't the most reliable of types but he shaped with promise when second on soft ground 24 days ago, although a more solid option might be HEDGING. Eve Johnson Houghton's charge takes a big drop in class and might go close back at the scene of his last victory.
