ATR VERDICT: Aidan O'Brien has a stellar record in this and could add to his tally with LOVE, who sets the standard following her victory in a Leopardstown Group 3 last time. She reversed form with Windracer on that occasion as well as accounting for stablemate So Wonderful, who is part of a four-strong Ballydoyle challenge along with Galway winner Petite Mustique and Tango. Soul Search (second) and Alpine Star (third) were behind the selection in a Leopardstown maiden last month, while the former is one half of Ger Lyon's respectable challenge alongside course winner French Rain.
